The unique high capacity filters provide cost effective water filtration solutions in a size and configuration that offer ease-of-use, **extended service life, and high capacity with a low pressure loss.** 

The chloramine block is a proprietary media with an enormous number of catalytically active nitrogen groups for highly efficient reduction of chloramines. This enhanced catalytic functionality has **five** times more capacity for chloramine reduction than standard carbon blocks.

All components and materials are made with FDA approved materials, manufactured from NSF 61 Certified Coconut Shell carbon, and are California Prop 65 Compliant. Each filter comes with a unique handle design for lightweight and easy removal, a bag for proper disposal, and a double O-ring connection for the Cartridge Tank \* plumbing adapter. 


